 Gadu garā apmācības programma sastāv no biznesa konceptu paskaidrojošiem moduļiem, kuros ietilpst biznesa dokumentu sagataves, piemēram, biznesa plāns un naudas plūsmas uzskaitē. Šie dokumenti veido uzdevumus biznesa menedžeru kvalifikācijai. Katrs apmācāmais katru apmācības modeli saņem ar e-pasta starpniecību un visi materiāli tiek adaptēti atbilstoši konkrētās valsts biznesa videi.

 Il programma della durata di un anno è composto di moduli che spiegano concetti sulla cultura d'impresa, insieme a schede informative che servono per la compilazione di documenti come il business plan e le previsioni di bilancio. La compilazione di questi documenti costituirà la prova finale per ottenere il diploma di business manager. L'utilizzo di e-mail assicura una maggiore accessibilità del programma e tutto il materiale è contestualizzato in riferimento alla situazione economica di ogni paese partner.

 The year-long programme is comprised of modules explaining business concepts, with associated templates to build business documents such as the business plan and cash flow forecast. These documents form the assignments for the business managers' qualification. Email delivery ensures increased accessibility of the programme and all material is contextualised to the business environment in each partner country.

## Consortium for Enterprise Outreach



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 **Konsorcijs uzņēmējdarbības veicināšanai** ir pilot projekts, kura mērķis ir palielināt akreditētu un arodizglītības programmu pieejamību. Šāda veida izglītības programma māca uzņēmējdarbību un nodrošinātu līdzvērtīgas iespējas iekļauties cilvēkiem ar invaliditāti izglītības iegūšanas procesā, kā arī viņu aprūpētājiem, kas vēlas būt pašnodarbināti, vai uzsākt savu uzņēmējdarbību.

Ar sadarbības partneru atbalstu no katras dalībvalsts (Lielbritānijas, Latvijas un Itālijas) 20 cilvēkiem ar invaliditāti un/vai viņu aprūpētājiem ar interneta palīdzību tiks dota iespēja apgūt šādu uzņēmējdarbības veicināšanas izglītības programmu.

Šī pilota apmācības programma rada iespējas cilvēkiem bez iepriekšējām zināšanām šajā jomā, iegūt Universitātes kvalifikāciju (Mazās uzņēmējdarbības vadības sertifikāts). Projekts nodrošinās to, ka programma ir pielāgota cilvēku ar invaliditāti vajadzībām, kā arī situācijai, ar kuru saskaras viņu aprūpētāji.


Projekta realizācijas laikā ir ieplānots radīt jaunus starptautiskus kontaktus, kas ietvers sadarbību starp uzņēmējiem, izglītības sistēmu un organizācijām, kas darbojas cilvēku ar invaliditāti interešu aizstāvības jomā, politikas veidotājiem un realizētājiem, kā arī cilvēkiem ar invaliditāti un viņu aprūpētājiem.

 **Consorzio di sostegno alle imprese** è un progetto pilota che mira a rendere accessibile una formazione professionale accreditata, per insegnare cultura d'impresa e fornire mentoring aziendale 'consapevole della problematica connessa alla disabilità', a coloro che sono disabili o cronicamente malati ma che desiderano diventare lavoratori autonomi e dare avvio ad un'attività.

20 disabili e/o assistenti per ogni nazione partner (Inghilterra, Lettonia e Italia) accederanno al programma di formazione d'impresa attraverso l'invio di e-mail settimanali ed il supporto di mentor aziendali.

Non necessitando di precedenti conoscenze sulla cultura d'impresa, il progetto pilota farà sì che il processo di autoimpiego si possa concretizzare in una opportunità di formazione con il rilascio di un diploma universitario (diploma in Small Business Management). CEO assicura che il programma è di rilevante importanza per la formazione del diversamente abile e per i loro assistenti.

La fase di sviluppo e di erogazione del progetto necessiterà di una nuova collaborazione internazionale, che implica cooperazione e collaborazione tra piccole aziende, università, organizzazioni che lavorano nel campo della disabilità, istituzioni, disabili e loro assistenti.

 **The Consortium for Enterprise Outreach** is a pilot project that aims to increase the availability of accessible, vocational and accredited education to teach enterprise and provide disability-aware business mentoring for those who are disabled or chronically ill, and carers, wishing to become self-employed or set up in business.

20 disabled individuals and/or carers from each partner country (UK, Latvia and Italy) will access the enterprise education programme through email delivery with support from disability-aware business mentors.

Assuming no prior business knowledge, the pilot project makes the process of becoming self-employed a learning opportunity with a University qualification (Certificate in Small Business Management). CEO will ensure that the programme is also relevant to the culture of disability and the situation faced by carers.

The pilot development and delivery will necessitate a new international partnership that involves co-operation and collaboration between small business, academia, organisations that work in the field of disability, policy makers, the disabled their carers.
